
A poll is a single question you pose to your audience.

Obtaining a Poll Everywhere Account with Institutional Privileges



Step 1. To create your first poll, click on the Create Poll button.

- If you are signed in, you can find the Create Poll button from your My Polls page.
- If you have not signed in, you can find the Create Poll button on the Poll Everywhere homepage.




Step 2. Type in your question




Step 3. Select the type of poll. Poll Everywhere offers several different poll types including multiple choice, open-ended response, and clickable image polls.


 For open-ended polls, select how you would like your audience's responses to be visualized.



• For multiple choice polls or true/false polls, type in your response options. You can also upload images as response options.



• For clickable image polls, upload the image you would like to use as your poll. You can define clickable regions to be counted for grading and reporting purposes.



Step 4. Click on the Create button to create the poll.
